






Mt Dorothy Discovery within Mary Kathleen JV with Goldsearch Limited (GSE:ASX)





Mt Dorothy Geology & Drilling Plan




Target Dimensions

- Chacopyrite & chalcocite sulphide breccia surrounded by lower grade native copper 'envelope'
- Phase 2 Depth & along-strike drilling in November to build dimension
- Cobalt credits
- Possible metallurgical test work after Phase 2 drilling.






Mt Dorothy Drillhole MDR002



Located 12 km south of Inca de Oro, Pan Aust project, 259Mt @ 0.46% copper and 0.13 g/t gold.






Chile - Drill Targets






CYU - Exposing Sino SOE to Greenfield Exploration Process
